By tracking sleep studies that had to be redone and standardizing the procedures for attaching the apnea machine to patients, team members at the Skyline Medical Office in Colorado were able to isolate the problem: the locks that fastened the device around a patient's torso weren't working properly. The manufacturer then replaced the locks. Fewer repeat studies means patients can get appointments faster.
